

Indy Grimo 2019 Coffin/Casket Specifications

All coffins MUST meet the following specifications. Coffins will be inspected prior to the race. Coffins not meeting the specifications will be disqualified at time of inspection, unless it is a minor alteration which can be addressed immediately on-site. Design-Build-Race accordingly!

Dimensions: (including handles and all projections)

- Minimum size of 2'-0" (24") wide by 5'-0" (60") long
- Maximum size 3'-10" (46") wide by 8'-0" (96") long
- There is a height restriction of 7'-6" (90") for the coffin/caskets and any of its protruding décor measured from the ground to the tallest point.
- Each coffin MUST have four securely attached wheels that are attached in such a manner so that the coffin will roll on all 4 (four) wheels when manually propelled down the race course. Wheels are NOT to exceed 10" in overall (outside diameter), including the tire. Wheels mountings must also fit within the overall dimensions of the coffin stated above. Casters may be used. For safety and steering ability wheels or casters are ALLOWED to rotate or swivel.
- Ropes used for pulling coffins will NOT be permitted. 4 (four) handles must be securely attached to the coffin/casket. A push bar style set-up is permitted at the front and rear in lieu of handles. However, the length of such bars must not exceed

dimensions previously stated. Please design your coffin to maximize safety by placing such push/pull handles at a comfortable height and location.

- Functional steering mechanisms are PROHIBITED.
- Decorative projections will be allowed but must not exceed the maximum width, length and height dimensions. Any use of props and or decorations must not be capable of causing any additional exposure to harm such as, but not limited to: sharps, glass, fire/flame containing objects, to name a few. If you are unsure, simply ask.
- All riders **MUST** wear a helmet during the race. Protective gear is highly recommended for pushers, but not required.
- Safety is imperative! Indy Grimo race officials “Coffin Crew” may disqualify any coffin if they feel it is unstable or dangerous.
